Black History Month All-Star: Clarissa Davis



Clarissa Davis was a two-time All-American forward and center for the University of Texas women's basketball team from 1985-86 through 1988-89 seasons, where she averaged 19.9 points and 8.7 rebounds a game. She was voted Most Outstanding Player as a freshman for the 1986 Final Four, which won the National Title, defeating Cheryl Miller and the USC Trojans. The Lady Longhorns were perfect with a 34-0 regular-season record. She was part of the 1992 Barcelona Olympic team, which won bronze, where she averaged 13 points and a steal a game.

She is the founder of TEAMXPRESS, a nonprofit organization whose mission is to provide role models to encourage literacy, help goal setting and community volunteering. They want to create NCAA basketball college scholarship opportunities through summertime activities. The program promotes characteristics of teamwork, sportsmanship and cooperation and mold positive role models.
